Definitely, book at least 6-9 months in advance to make sure you get your must-haves such as a private plunge pool or a quiet beachfront suite with outdoor shower. Often, you'll also be able to take advantage of early booking deals.

- 2. Pick your destination wisely.** The Destination Can Make or Break the Bank. If budget is a major priority, consider places like Mexico and Jamaica where airfares tend to be lower and accommodation rates can be great values.

If you are dreaming of romantic, far away places like Fiji and Tahiti, adjust your budget accordingly as airfares and accommodations tend to be far more expensive than one expects. Also note that while Bora Bora, Maldives, and Fiji are amazing honeymoon destinations, these are not ideal if you have less than one week for your honeymoon. Consider European destinations such as the south of France, Italy's Amalfi coast, or Spain instead.

An exotic destination is awesome if you have enough travel time and don't mind long flights. Some destinations require over a day traveling time and you also need adjust to time difference. A travel expert can advise you on off-season times for these destinations if you are flexible on your honeymoon's timing.

- 3. Budget for your honeymoon early.** Before you get caught up in planning the wedding, discuss with your partner what are the must-

have experiences for both of you while on your honeymoon: a particular honeymoon suite, adventure, relaxation, touring, food and wine? Make a list together and come up with a realistic budget (a travel expert will gladly help with this) before you get swept up in the moment and spend extra on the wedding. 6. **Make sure that both you and your partner have a valid 10-year passport.** Note that most countries now require that passports be valid for at least 6 months beyond your travel dates. Check your passports now before you get caught up with planning the wedding. If you do require a new passport, be sure to allow plenty of time to get your new passport.

7. **Buy travel insurance.** There are all sorts of circumstances that could cause you to cancel your trip, return home early or force you to seek emergency medical treatment while traveling. Travel insurance provides protection against unforeseen circumstances and is often relatively cheap compared to what you've already invested in your trip.

8. **Pack before the wedding and plan your wardrobe,** especially if you are planning to visit multiple destinations that might involve city/beach/countryside and so on. Shorts, sunhats, and sunscreen are strongly recommended for hot sunny destinations. And you'll be surprised how often people forget to pack that sexy bikini they've been dying to wear and/or swim trunks! Also, don't forget to pack evening wear for nights on the city (restaurants, theater, clubbing, etc.).
